DRIVE iQ

What is Drive iQ?

Drive iQ is virtual driving software made up of over 30 interactive online modules. Some modules can be completed before you start learning and aim to improve the skills such as: anticipating danger, risk assessment, emotional response, eye scanning and impulse. Other modules complement practical driving lessons and bring the theory of learning to life. There are also modules to help you when you have just passed your test i.e. Motorways.

Why do I need to do Drive iQ?

It is estimated that 95% of crashes involving young drivers aren't anything to do with vehicle handling skills i.e. the stuff you learn to get your licence like Mirror, Signal, Manoeuvre. Completing Drive iQ fills the gap in your knowledge to make sure you understand how things like attitude, behaviour and distraction can affect your driving and your ability to stay safe in a car (as both a driver and passenger).

Being involved in a road crash is the most likely thing to cause death or a life changing injury for a 16-24 year old in the UK. Alarmingly, 1 in 5 young drivers crash in their first year of driving.

How will Drive iQ make me a better driver?

Drive iQ is based on proven science and using the programme will help you think and react like an older and more experienced driver. Understanding how human factors such as; mood, anxiety, fatigue, stress, a lack of planning or concentration put a usually competent driver (and their passengers) at risk is key. Drive iQ's virtual platform allows you to experience simulated situations and use the experience you gain to self-reflect and have time to work out how best to proceed. This experience and recall will be invaluable when you take to the road for that first 1,000 or so miles.
